A FORMAL RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CHINO VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT AMENDING THE 2012 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE.

WHEREAS, the Chino Valley Fire District did, on or about, September 18, 2014, adopt the 2012 International Fire Code together with certain amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Chino Valley Fire District is authorized, pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-805(B)(6) to adopt a nationally recognized fire code and amend or revise the adopted code.

WHEREAS, the Chino Valley Fire District wishes to amend the 2012 Edition of the International Fire Code to provide for a more uniform practice and enforcement of the Fire Code, consistent and together with various other enforcement agencies with whom Central Yavapai Fire District may interact; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chino Valley Fire District hereby amends the 2012 Edition of the International Fire Code, Appendix D, Table D103.4

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional; such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution and the rules, regulations, provisions, amendments, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval.

**APPENDIX D**

**Table D103.4** is amended to read as follows:

In lieu of the required 96-foot diameter, a cul-de-sac with an 82-foot diameter drivable surface with no parking signs posted throughout may be allowed if approved by the fire code official.
